Sun Olive Hot Spring Resort

A hot spring resort with sweeping views over the Uchinomi Bay that can be visited in a single day.

You can enjoy eight types of hot springs and two types of saunas, including herbal baths, lie-down baths, and far infrared saunas.

- Closed on Wednesdays and Thursdays

Greek Windmill

This white windmill creates a strikingly beautiful contrast to the blue of the Seto Inland Sea, reminiscent of the Aegean Sea. It was built as a symbol of the sister island relationship between Shodoshima Island and Milos Island in Greece. It is also a popular photo spot. It is illuminated for about 2 hours after sunset.

Olive Road

Walking down Olive Hill, the evergreen leaves shake in the wind and their silver undersides glitter in the sunlight. The calm waters of the Seto Inland Sea and blue sky can also be seen through the trees.

Shodoshima Olive Garden

The garden, the first of its kind in Japan, grows approximately 2,000 olive trees. The garden shop sells various olive products, such as cosmetics and edible olive oil made from the olives harvested and processed in the park. You can purchase at the direct store price.

Original Olive Tree

The garden owns the oldest original olive tree of any private gardens in Japan. The original olive tree continues to grow on Olive Hill, which is an excellent location from which you can see the Tanoura and the Mito Peninsulas beyond the Uchinomi Bay.

Isamu Noguchi's Playground

Isamu Noguchi created play equipment sculptures to bring art into daily life. This installation consists of three kinds of sculptures. Playing here, you can enjoy an open and unique world where children can discover and enter into a dialogue with the sky, the sea, the sun, the moon, stars and the universe. Enjoy your time with your mind and body.

ARTETRA

The AKARI series is famous as another art element of Isamu Noguchi. The soft light produced by the Japanese-style lighting equipment is in harmony with furniture designed by Isamu Noguchi in this space. Here, the worldview of Isamu Noguchi, the artist who loved nature, is skillfully expressed.

Tower of Civilization & Oratorio

In 1586, 1,400 islanders were baptized into Christianity. According to Japanese historical records, the Christian feudal lord Konishi Yukinaga built a 15-meter high crucifix and prayed for happiness. The Tower of Civilization is a crucifix that commemorates the 400 year anniversary of the introduction of Christianity to Japan. The building on the right of the Tower of Civilization is an oratorio (prayer house).

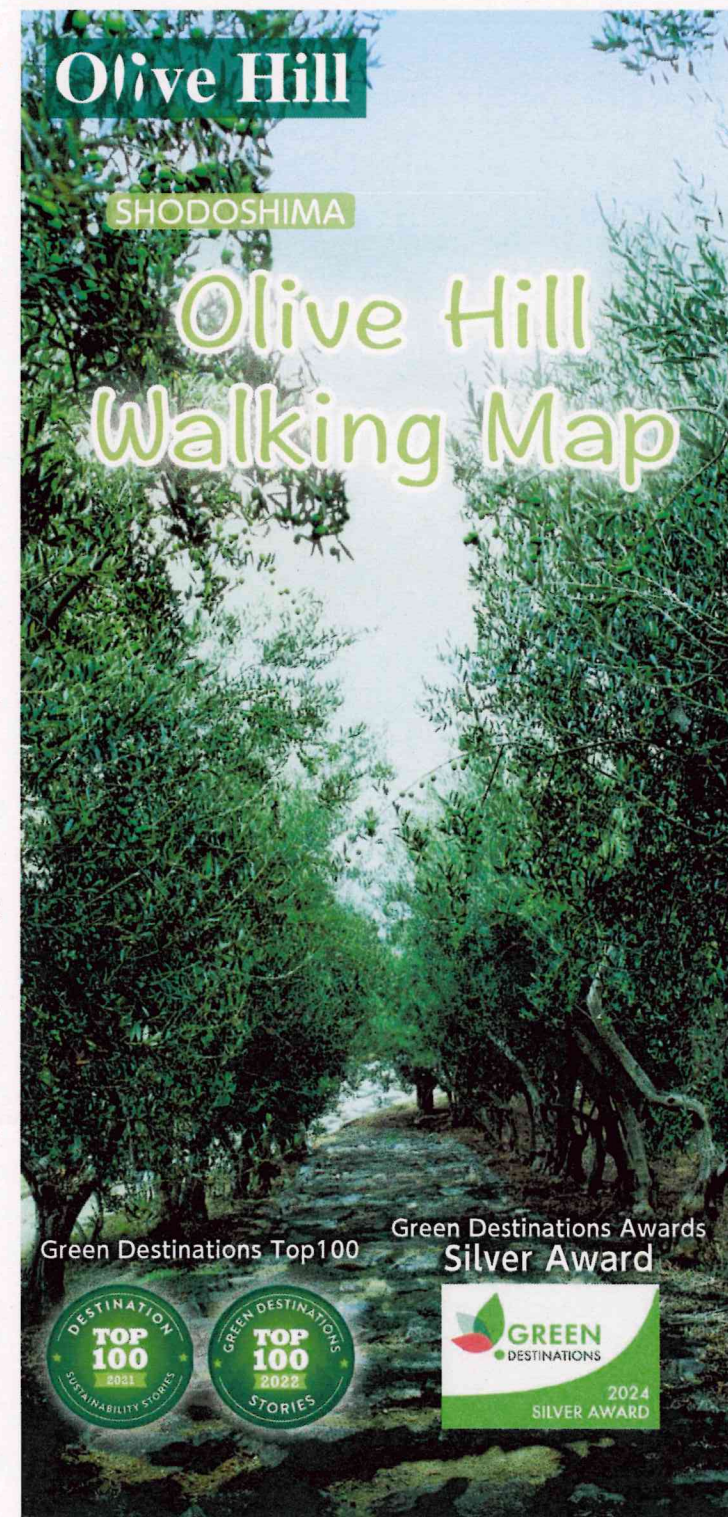
Monument to the Birthplace of Olives

Olives were introduced to Shodoshima in 1908 (Meiji 41), and cultivation of olives has succeeded thanks to the tireless efforts of our predecessors. Shodoshima became the birthplace of olive cultivation in Japan.

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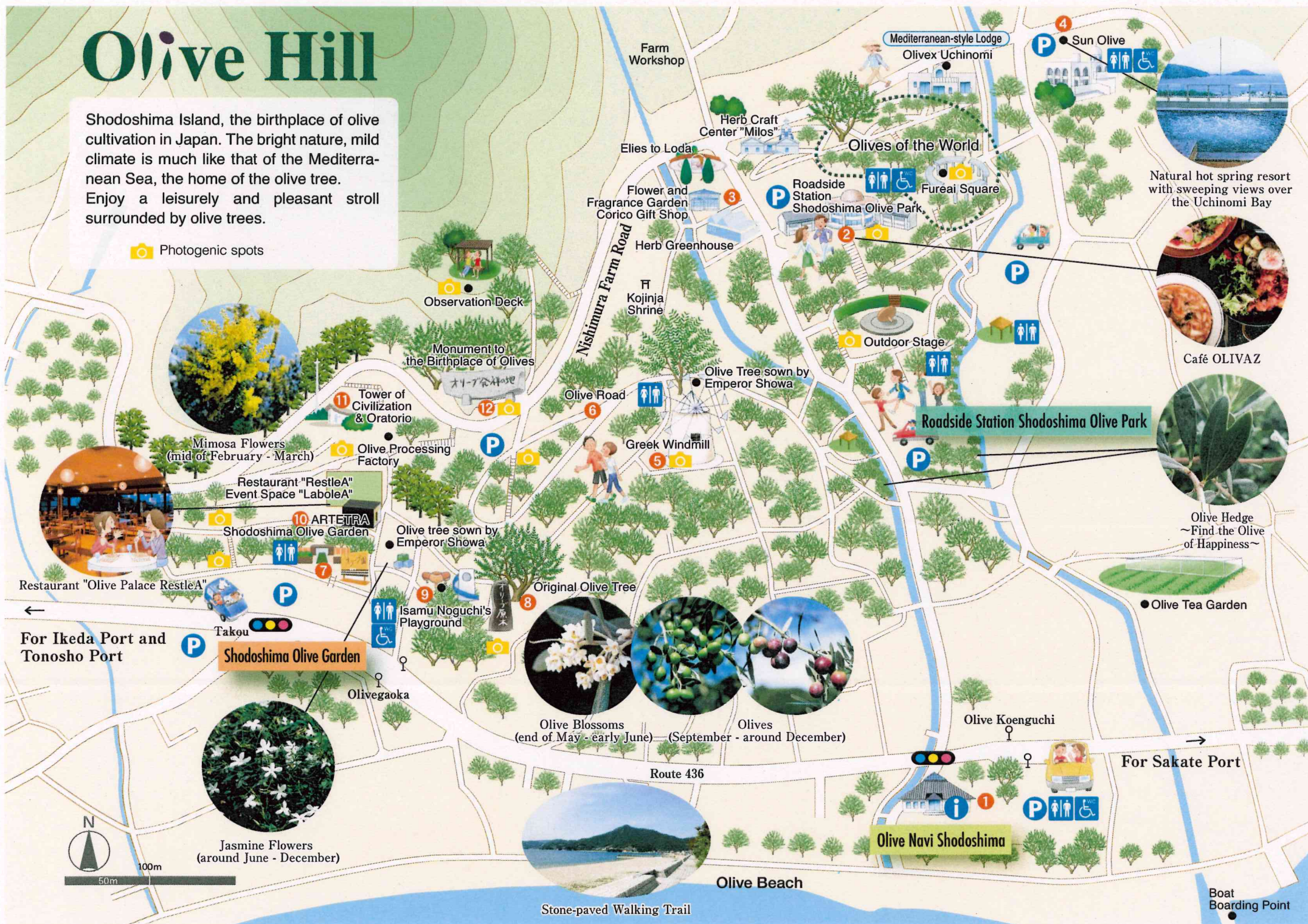
